Collegiate Circuit Court issues criterion on nullity of trademarks

September 2, 2022, the Judicial Weekly of the Federation (Semanario Judicial de la Federación) published the isolated Thesis registration 2025191, by which the Fourth Collegiate Court in Administrative Matters of t h e Circuit issued its criteria regarding the way in which the Mexican Institute of Industrial Property (IMPI) must prove the updating of the "uninterrupted use" in cases of administrative nullification declarations of trademarks due to prior

Such Thesis has its origin resolution of Amparo 186/2022, in which a person requested the nullification of a registered trademark, arguing that he/she enjoys a better right for having used a similar sign abroad, previously uninterruptedly. In this regard, Collegiate Circuit Court in charge of the decision determined that the IMPI must provide grounds and reasons for its assessment regarding the uninterrupted use, that is, it m u s t explanation of the reasons that led it to consider that the use of the trademark enjoyed the better effectively uninterrupted, taking account t h e number of operations.
