New security mechanism of the Hague System

The Hague System of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) -for the registration of industrial designs simultaneously in several countries through a single international application- has implemented strong authentication. This is a security mechanism for secure access to its online services. This has been done as a result of technological advances, in order to protect sensitive data by ensuring secure access to design registration procedures, registrations and online applications. As of June 28, 2023, users will be required to set up at least one strong authentication option in their WIPO account for identity proofing purposes; a single password will no longer suffice to log in.

The thesis with digital registry [2026451](#) under the title "*RES JUDICATA. THE ONE DERIVED FROM THE JUDGMENT THAT DECLARED THE NULLITY OF THE PROCEEDING OF EXECUTION OF PROVISIONAL MEASURES CARRIED OUT BY THE MEXICAN INSTITUTE OF INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY (IMPI), DOES NOT RESULT IN THE INVALIDITY OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE INFRINGEMENT PROCEEDING INITIATED ON THE OCCASION OF SUCH PROCEEDING*" was published on May 19, 2023 in the Judicial Weekly of the Federation

In such precedent, the Tenth Collegiate Court in Administrative Matters of the First Circuit ruled that the nullity of the provisional measures proceeding does not invalidate, due to *res judicata*, the administrative infringement declaration proceeding before the Mexican Institute of Industrial Property.

The foregoing, under the justification that the provisional measures proceeding and the infringement proceeding pursue different purposes and are processed independently. However, the evidentiary material gathered in the proceeding for provisional measures cannot be used in the subsequent infringement proceeding.
