On September 8, 2023, the First Chamber of the Mexican Supreme Court published a thesis with digital registration number 2027153, titled “ACCESS TO CULTURE AND CULTURAL HERITAGE. THE REGULATORY SYSTEM ESTABLISHED IN THE GENERAL LIBRARY LAW THAT REGULATES THE LEGAL DEPOSIT ENSURES THIS RIGHT”

Through this precedent, issued by the First Chamber of the Mexican Supreme Court, it was resolved that the legal deposit of publications, established in the General Library Law, ensures the right to culture and cultural heritage. This is related to access to cultural goods and the right to participate in cultural life, as established in international treaties and the Constitution.

This is in line with the obligation to preserve cultural heritage and guarantee the exercise of cultural rights of individuals.

The First Chamber of the Mexican Supreme Court published on September 8, 2023, a thesis with digital registration number 2027171, titled “Legal Deposit for Cultural Heritage in the country's Library System. The obligation contained in the general library law to deliver literary copies corresponds to a duty of solidarity and is not subject to fiscal justice principles”. Obeying the commitment of the authorities to interpret norms in accordance with international treaties and the Federal Copyright Law, it was resolved that the articles of the General Law of Libraries that establish the obligation of publishers and producers to deliver copies for the legal deposit of publications are constitutional. On September 8, 2023, the Mexican Supreme Court published a thesis with digital registration number 2027157, titled “Expiration of the Administrative Declaration Procedure Provided for in article 188 of the Abrogated Industrial Property Law. The supplementary application of article 60 of the Federal Administrative Law applies during the processing stage, not during the issuance of the resolution”.

Through this precedent, issued by the Fourth Collegiate Court in Administrative Matters of the First Circuit, it was resolved that the supplementary application of Article 60 of the Federal Administrative Law applies during the processing stage, not during the issuance of the resolution. This is because it could unfairly affect the petitioner without reason, and the procedure should be driven to its resolution.

This is due to the obligation of authorities to resolve procedures and avoid unnecessary delays, actively pushing the procedure until its resolution.

The thesis with digital registration number 2027193, titled “General Library Law. The regulatory system that governs the figure of legal deposit of publications is constitutional, as it does not violate the rights of authors to decide on the availability of their works and to use technological measures for their protection” was published by the First Chamber of the Mexican Supreme Court on September 8, 2023.

Through this precedent, issued by the First Chamber of the Mexican Supreme Court, it was resolved that the articles of the General Library Law that establish the obligation of publishers and producers to deliver copies for legal deposit of publications are constitutional. This is due to the obligation of authorities to interpret norms in accordance with international treaties and the Federal Copyright Law.
